Tender document and supporting documents must be placed in a sealed envelope clearly marked "E/10/17-18: ANALYSIS OF WATER SAMPLES FOR A PERIOD OF THREE YEARS" must be deposited in the tender box of the Eden District Municipality, Supply Chain Management Unit, 54 York Street, George. Tenders may only be submitted on the tender document issues by the Municipality. Requirements for sealing, addressing, delivery, opening and assessment of tenders are stated in the tender document. Important note: A valid original Tax Clearance Certificate and certified copies of directors and owners' identity documents must be submitted with the tender documentation. VAT must be included in all prices. No late tenders, tenders per facsimile or – e-mail and tenders per post will be accepted. Council reserves the right to accept any tender or part thereof, and with the increase in price of any of the commodities, its purchase of those commodities from the specific tenderer will be considered and to determine the period of tenders to be awarded. It will be required from service providers to register on the Central Supplier Database (CSD) from the website https://secure.csd.gov.za Tenders will not be considered should the prerequisites not met.
