General points:

- 1. From the available data, we are still in a good position currently.
- 2. The active cases per 100 000 has gone up slightly.

The main developing concern is for George, where we are starting to see renewed activity.

Although Mossel Bay has also gone up, there are a few duplicate names on the system that must be resolved, so for now not a cause of main concern.

Oudtshoorn's daily active number remains relatively high, but remains in constant range.

We continue to monitor activity.

- 3. All district hospitals manageable presently and not under pressure.
- 4. George Hospital: 50% use of general Covid beds (52% last week) and 13% of critical care beds (also 13% last week).
- 5. Focus at moment is planning and implementation of the vaccination campaign.

George Hospital has started with it. It is the only designated site in Garden Route for now.

1 030 vaccinations given in total so far.

George Hospital, George sub-district, Knysna, Bitou and Mossel Bay have been recipients so far.

- 6. Ongoing vigilance to be in place to delay third wave as long as possible.
- 7. Gateway Lodge is now closed as a Quarantine/Isolation site. Petrosa is our only active site.
