Total new cases last 7 days vs 7-14 days ago: 149 : 169 12% decrease

General points:

1. There has been a welcome further decrease in active cases per 100 000 for the district as a whole.
This is not so for Hessequa, but the change is negligible, and not of concern.
2. Decrease in totals of last 7 days vs 7-14 days ago, which is very good.
3. Thembalethu, George had 12 new cases this last weekend; careful monitoring and support to be in place.
4. Ongoing planning and implementation for Covid vaccine program taking place.
Full quota of 320 vaccines received last week were utilized, and 320 health workers vaccinated.
Expect next tranche of vaccines to arrive Monday, 8 March 2021
For the week of 8-12 March 2021, health workers from George, Mossel Bay and Knysna will be vaccinated.
