**General points:**

1. There is a change being seen in the numbers, with most sub-districts increasing in their active/100 000.
2. Some concern at this point is for Oudtshoorn.

George has also increased, but the numbers are fluctuating.

Knysna, which has been stable for a long time, is also slowly starting to increase.

Mossel Bay has stabilized well.

Hessequa, Bitou and Kannaland: no issues.

All these increases are from a very low base, so small numbers have big % increases.

The next two weeks will give us a good indication of what the trend is.

Distribution is wide-spread with no clear clusters.

3. George Hospital: 33% use of general Covid beds (up from 29% last week) and 4% of critical care beds (up from 0% of last week).  
All district hospitals manageable presently and not under pressure. Oudtshoorn Hospital starting to show a small increase.
4. Focus at moment is planning and implementation of the vaccination campaign: Phase 1B and Phase 2&3.  
The vaccine program is however temporarily on hold because of certain side effects seen internationally.  
We hope it will resume again soon.
