

Tariffs- Tariffs are cost reflective and tariff modelling are performed to ensure that all costs incurred to deliver a service are recovered. The increases in tariffs is in line with the inflation rate. The increase in the electricity tariffs of 14.59% is directly related to the electricity increases by Eskom
