General points:

1. There is a big increase in new cases and a big increase in the active/100 000.

Mossel Bay and then George have the highest rates/100 000.

For Mossel Bay, there is widespread distribution of cases and the emerging hot spot is Groot Brak River.

Hessequa, which has been very stable, has had a big increase in the last few days.

Knysna and Bitou have remained stable, but today two clusters identified, one family in Hornlee and one in Whale Rock, Plett. Will see numbers coming through with tomorrow's data.

Oudtshoorn only increasing slowly.

Kannaland remaining with low numbers.

- 2. Distribution is wide-spread.
- 3. George Hospital stable at the moment. Covid ward 19% full and High Care 17% full.

All district hospitals manageable presently and not under pressure.

4. Private hospital in Mossel Bay very busy and in George picking up also.

Vaccine Program

- 1. Up till now, a total of 17 286 vaccines have been given in the Garden Route.
- 2. For today, a total of 1 927 were given. This was for old-age homes and also select sites.
- 3. Vaccines are allocated to us on a weekly basis and our target is to use all up before the next batch arrives. This has essentially been done up till now.
- 4. We are expecting a Vaccine Program to be implemented for the Education Dept in the last two weeks of June. We await further developments on this.

This will be in addition to the regular vaccine program which will run concurrently.

In general, the health dept is under increasing pressure with the rise in Covid cases, and ensuring all the vaccinations take place at the same time.

But all systems are fully functional.

Registration of > 60s.

We are still under 50% in total of all registrations and call upon our partners to review how this registration process can be supported by them.
