General points:

- 1. The situation is greatly continued to improve in all subdistricts.
- 2. All sub-districts show a decrease in the rate/100 000.
- 3. There has been a minor decrease (10%) in new cases in last 7 days compared to 7-14 days ago.
- 4. Inpatient numbers in all the hospitals have decreased. Oudtshoorn Hospital still has a higher burden of in patients, but it is also decreasing there. Bed occupancy rate for Covid is 28% compared to 40% a week ago.
- 5. George Hospital has closed its one general Covid ward and is using it now for general patients and decreased the Covid Critical Care beds. The Critical Care Unit is 30% full compared to 42% a week ago.
- 6. All hospitals are managable.

- 1. We have tested the waters for weekend vaccinations there has been a very poor response.
- 2. Generally, there is a decreased demand for vaccinations and our sites remain under-utilized. We are starting to focus now on outreaches instead.
- 3. We receive sufficient Pfizer vaccines for all our needs. We received 6120 one-dose J&J vaccine this week. We have not received any complaints in the past 2 months regarding availability of vaccines
