General points:

- 1. The situation is greatly continued to improve in all subdistricts.
- 2. All sub-districts show a decrease in the rate/100 000.
- 3. There has been a 39% decrease in new cases in last 7 days compared to 7-14 days ago. The decrease is higher than the provincial decrease of 34%.
- 4. Oudtshoorn Hospital still has a higher burden of inpatients the bed occupancy rate for Covid is 30% compared to 28% a week ago.
- 5. George Hospital has closed its one general Covid ward and is using it now for general patients and decreased the Covid Critical Care beds. The Critical Care Unit is still 30% full, the same as a week ago.
- 6. All hospitals are managable.

Way forward for

vaccinations:

- 1. There has been a very poor response to weekend vaccinations. Only Harry Comay continued with weekend vaccinations.
- 2. Generally, there is a decreased demand for vaccinations and some of the vaccination sites remain under-utilized. Sub-Districts are in process to re-strategize, maybe to intergrate vaccinations within the PHC platform.
- 3. We have sufficient Pfizer and one-dose J&J vaccines for all our needs. Next delivery for both Phizer and J&J will be on the 18th October 2021. We have not received any complaints in the past 2 months regarding availability of vaccines.
