General points:

1. The situation is relative stable in all sub-districts.
2. Bitou, George, Knysna, Mossel Bay and Oudtshoorn show an increase in the rate/100 000, the rate doubled in George, Knysna and Mossel Bay. The district rate is 18/100 000 compared to 10 a week ago but much lower than the provincial rate of 32/100 000.
3. There has been a 152% increase in new cases in last 7 days compared to 7-14 days ago. The district increase is much lower compared to the provincial increase of 424%.
4. Oudtshoorn and Knysna Hospitals have none confirmed Covid inpatients. There is 1 confirmed Covid inpatient in Mossel Bay Hospital
5. George Hospital has closed its one general Covid ward and is using it now for general patients and decreased the Covid Critical Care beds. There are 2 confirmed Covid patients in the general Covid ward, none in the Critical
6. All hospitals are manageable.

**Way forward for
vaccinations:**

1. There has been a very poor response to weekend vaccinations. Harry Comay Hospital and Thembaletu Clinic continued with alternative weekend vaccinations.
2. Generally, there is a decreased demand for vaccinations and some of the vaccination sites remain under-utilized. Sub-Districts are in process to re-strategize to integrate vaccinations within the PHC platform.
3. We have sufficient Pfizer and one-dose J&J vaccines for all our needs. Orders ordered on a weekly basis according to usage. We have not received any complaints in the past 2 months regarding availability of vaccines.
4. The **third VOOMA** weekend will take place on 3-5 December 2021.
