General points:

1. There is a decrease in the number of active cases in all sub-districts, the total for the district decreased from 5 338 on 3 January 2022 to 3 996 on 10 January 2022.

2. Only Kannaland sub-district show an increase in the rate/100 000. The district rate is 646/100 000 compared to 862/100 00 on 3 January 2022 but still higher than the provincial rate of 411/100 000. The district rate is still the highest among all the districts.

3. There has been a 21% decrease in new cases in the last 7 days compared to 7-14 days ago.

4. All the district hospitals are manageable. There were 49 Covid positive cases admitted in District hospitals compared to 44 a week ago - 16 in Riversdale Hospital, 5 in Mossel Bay Hospital, 5 in Knysna Hospital, 21 in Oudtshoorn hospital and one each in Uniondale and Harry Comay Hospitals.

5. George Hospital has 39 Covid patients in the general ward and 3 in ICU/High Care.

Vaccine Program (data available until 7/1/2022)

- J&J Program (total): 69 769
- Pfizer first dose: 167 968
- Total people with at least one dose: 237 737

Total people with second dose Pfizer: 135 065

Sisonke programme - A total of 5 126 Health Care Workers received the booster dose till 7/1/2022.

Total % of population > 50yrs fully vaccinated: 67% (same as a week ago)

Total % of population 18-49 years partially vaccinated: 47% (1 percentage point increase from a week ago)

4. Policy development:

4.1. Immunocompromised adults 18 years and older was eligible to receive an additional dose of Covid-19 vaccine as from 1st December 2021. A total of 331 vaccines were administered till 7/1/2022.

4.2 J&J boosters are available from 24 December 2021 at all sites where there is J&J stock. A total of 566 people received the booster dose till 7/1/2022.

4.3. Pfizer boosters are available from 28 Dec 2021. From historical dates of the start of the second Pfizer, we expect the booster doses only to start \pm 10 January 2021. Only 235 people received the booster dose till 7/1/2022.
