General points:

1. From previous week, there is a decrease in the number of active cases in all sub-districts, the total for the district decreased from 822 on 31 January 2022 to 728 on 7 February 2022.
2. Hessequa and Oudtshoorn sub-districts show an increase in the rate/100 000. The district rate is 118/100 000 compared to 142/100 000 on 31 January 2022 but slightly higher than the provincial rate of 110/100 000. The district rate is the second highest among all the districts.
3. There has been a zero per cent decrease in new cases in the last 7 days compared to 7-14 days ago. The decrease is less than the Provincial decrease of 3%.
4. All the district hospitals are quiet. There are 8 Covid positive cases admitted in district hospitals, five more than a week ago - 0 in Riversdale Hospital, 0 in Ladismith Hospital, 1 in Knysna Hospital, 1 in Mossel Bay Hospital, 0 in Uniondale Hospital, 0 in Oudtshoorn hospital and 6 in Harry Comay Hospital.
5. George Hospital has 11 Covid patients in the general ward and 1 in Critical Care.

Policy development

1. National Cabinet meeting of 31 Jan 2022: new policy directives for Quarantine and Isolation to be implemented.
2. These new directives will greatly ease stipulations for Q and I.
