**General points:**

1. From previous week, there is a decrease in the number of active cases in all sub-districts, the total for the district decreased from 728 on 7 February 2022 to 633 on 14 February 2022.
2. Hessequa and Kannaland sub-districts show an increase in the rate/100 000. The district rate is 102/100 000 compared to 118/100 000 on 7 February 2022 and on par with the provincial rate of 101/100 000. The district rate is the second highest among all the districts.
3. There has been a 5% decrease in new cases in the last 7 days compared to 7-14 days ago. The district had a decrease compared to the Provincial increase of 1%.
4. All the district hospitals are quiet. There were 11 Covid positive cases admitted in district hospitals on 14/2/2022, three more than a week ago - 0 in Riversdale Hospital, 0 in Ladismith Hospital, 1 in Knysna Hospital, 1 in Mossel Bay Hospital, 0 in Uniondale Hospital, 5 in Oudtshoorn hospital and 4 in Harry Comay Hospital.  
5 George Hospital has 10 Covid patients in the general ward, one in Critical Care.

**Policy development**

1. National Cabinet meeting of 31 Jan 2022: new policy directives for Quarantine and Isolation to be implemented.
2. These new directives will greatly ease stipulations for Q and I.
