General points:

- 1. From previous week, there is an increase in the number of active cases in Knysna sub-district, the total for the district decreased from 550 on 21 February 2022 to 446 on 28 February 2022.
- 2. Knysna sub-district shows an increase in the rate/100 000. The district rate is 72/100 000 compared to 89/100 00 on 21 February 2022 and lower than the provincial rate of 93/100 000. The district rate is the third lowest among all the districts.

- 3. There has been a 15% decrease in new cases in the last 7 days compared to 7-14 days ago and more than the Provincial decrease of only 1%.
- 4. All the district hospitals are quiet. There were 2 Covid positive cases admitted in district hospitals on 28/2/2022, four less than a week agos 0 in Riversdale Hospital, 0 in Ladismith Hospital, 1 in Knysna Hospital, 1 in Mossel Bay Hospital, 0 in Uniondale Hospital, 0 in Oudtshoorn hospital and 0 in Harry Comay Hospital.
- 5. George Hospital has 2 Covid patients in the general ward, none in Critical Care.

Policy development

- 1. Implementation of Circular H20 of 2022: Contact tracing, Isolation, Quarantine and Testing remains in place. The Petro SA has closed.
- 2. Implementation of Circular H21 of 2022: Policy on visitors and escorts at health facilities during the 4th covid inter-wave.

Way forward for vaccinations:

- 1. There remains a poor response to vaccinations. However, there was an increase in the uptake of Vaccinations in Mossel Bay sub-district in the past week.
- 2. We have sufficient Pfizer and one-dose J&J vaccines for all our needs.
- 3. Implementation of Circular H15 of 2022: integrating Covid-19 vaccination as part of routine care on the health service platform (infacility and community-based platform). Integration of Covid-19 vaccination must be geared towards achieving the targets across the different age bands and geographic areas.
- 4. Implementation of Circular H18 of 2022: changes to dosing intervals and introduction of heterlogous booster doses.

⁻ From 21/2/2022: The interval between the first and second doses of the Pfizer vaccine will be reduced

from 42 days to 21 days.

- -From 23/2/2022: Individuals over 18 years who have received 2 doses of Pfizer vaccine will be eligible to receive the booster dose of the same vaccine or a booster dose of J&J after 90 days
- From 23/2/2022: Individuals over 18 years who have received a J&J vaccine will be eligible to receive the booster dose of the same vaccine or a booster dose of Pfizer after 60 days.
- -Persons who have received 2 J&J vaccines are currently fully vaccinated and do no require additional Pfizer vaccine.
 - 5. Implementation of Circular H22 of 2022: co-administration of Covid-19 and other vaccines.
