General points:

- 1. From previous week, there was a slightly increase in the number of active cases in Bitou, Kannaland, Knysna and Mossel Bay sub-districts, the total for the district decreased from 446 on 28 February 2022 to 425 on 3 March 2022.
- 2. The same sub-districts show an increase in the rate/100 000. The district rate is 69/100 000 compared to 72/100 000 on 28 February 2022 but higher than the provincial rate of 85/100 000. The district rate is the 4th lowest among all the districts.

- 3. There has been a 17% increase in new cases (32 cases) in the last 7 days compared to 7-14 days ago and more than the Provincial decrease of 8%.
- 4. All the district hospitals are quiet. There were 2 Covid positive cases admitted in district hospitals on 7/3/2022 1 in Riversdale Hospital, 0 in Ladismith Hospital, 0 in Knysna Hospital, 0 in Mossel Bay Hospital, 0 in Uniondale Hospital, 0 in Oudtshoorn hospital and 1 in Harry Comay Hospital.
- 5. George Hospital has 5 Covid patients in the general ward, none in Critical Care.

A total of 5 063 people received the J&J booster dose.

- 1. There remains a poor response to vaccinations.
- 2. We have sufficient Pfizer and one-dose J&J vaccines for all our needs.
