General

points:

1. From previous week, there was an increase in the number of active cases in George, Kannaland and Mossel Bay sub-districts, the total for the district increased slightly from 425 on 7 March 2022 to 439 on 14 March 2022.
2. The same sub-districts show an increase in the rate/100 000. The district rate is 71/100 000 compared to 69/100 000 on 7 March 2022 and slightly lower than the provincial rate of 79/100 000. The district rate is the 2nd highest among all the districts.
3. There has been a 5% decrease in new cases in the last 7 days compared to 7-14 days ago and more than the Provincial decrease of 0%.
4. All the district hospitals are quiet. There were 2 Covid positive cases admitted in district hospitals on 14/3/2022 - 0 in Riversdale Hospital, 0 in Ladismith Hospital, 0 in Knysna Hospital, 0 in Mossel Bay Hospital, 0 in Uniondale Hospital, 1 in Oudtshoorn hospital and 1 in Harry Comay Hospital.
5. George Hospital has 3 Covid patients in the general ward, one in Critical Care.

Way forward for

vaccinations:

1. There remains a poor response to vaccinations.
2. We have sufficient Pfizer and one-dose J&J vaccines for all our needs.
3. Implementation of Circular H38 of 2022: Introduction of second booster dose after vaccination with Covid-19 vaccine Jansen (J&J). Effective 14 March 2022, all individuals who have received one booster dose following primary vaccination with COVID-19 vaccine Janssen®, will be eligible to receive an additional booster dose 90 days after the first booster dose.
