

GARDEN ROUTE VISION 2040

Urbanisation/Immigration

- Research reveals that:
 - 63% of South Africans already live in urban areas
 - This will rise to 71% by 2030
 - By 2050, 8 in 10 South Africans will live in Urban Areas
 - Over 55% of the global population reside in cities
 - But those cities are responsible for more that 80% of global GDP
 - Places increasing demand on basic infrastructure requirements
- In-light of the above; urban areas are facing the following challenges:
 - Dysfunctional Spatial Patterns
 - Poorly located and maintained infrastructure.
 Weak spatial planning and governance.
 - Pressure on housing and basic services



JUNE 20, 2010, COUNCIL MEETING

- Council Resolved in formal submission of Level 1
 Accreditation with Minister of Human Settlements in the Western Cape
- Rationale was dictated primarily by provisions in the Constitution, and further, by the logic of cooperative governance and current constraints in the housing delivery process.
- <u>Strategic objective 1</u> of Creating Healthy and Socially Stable Communities and <u>Strategic objective 3</u> ensuring Bulk Infrastructure Coordination.
