General points:

Policy development

No new policies/circulars. The District office is busy working on a 5th Wave draft preparedness plan. 5th wave to be expected at the end of April and beginning May 2022.

Latest available data (26/4/2022)

- The data from the NDOH dashboard is used for reporting.
- The latest available data till 26/4/2022 shows the following:
 - o Total first doses given:
J&J Program (total): 76 534
Pfizer program: 175 259
 - o Total second dose Pfizer given: 148 161
- Up till now:
 - o Percentage of total Garden Route population who have received at least one dose vaccine: 45.49%.
- There is sufficient stock on hand.
- A total of 460 immunocompromised vaccines were administered to adults 18 years and older.

Way forward for vaccinations:

1. There remains a poor response to vaccinations.
2. We have sufficient Pfizer and one-dose J&J vaccines for all our needs.
