1 Agreement

The successful bidder will be expected to sign the Contract Form (Part 1) of this bid document within 30 days of the date of notification by the Garden Route District Municipality that his/her bid has been accepted.

2 Completion of Bid Documents

- (a) The original bid document must be completed fully in black ink and signed by the authorised signatory to validate the proposal. All the pages must be initialled by the authorised signatory. Failure to do so may result in the invalidation of the bid.
- (b) Bid documents may not be retyped or altered in any way.

3 Alteration or Qualification of Bid

No unauthorised alteration of this set of bid documents will be allowed. Any unauthorised alteration will disqualify the proposal automatically. Any ambiguity has to be cleared with contact person for the bid before the closure date.

4 Authorised Signatory

- (a) A copy of the recorded Resolution taken by the Board of Directors, members, partners or trustees authorising the representative to submit this bid on the bidder's behalf must be attached to the Bid Document on submission of same.
- (b) A bid shall be eligible for consideration only if it bears the signature of the bidder or of some person duly and lawfully authorised to sign it for and on behalf of the bidder.

5 Submission of Bid

- (a) The bid must be put in a sealed envelope, or envelopes when the two-envelope system is specified, clearly marked with the bid number, title as well as closing date and time and placed in the **Tender Box at the Garden Route District Municipality by not later than 11h00 on 19 October 2022**
- (b) Faxed, e-mailed and late bids will not be accepted. Bids may be delivered by hand, by courier, or posted at the bidder's risk and must be received by the deadline specified above, irrespective of how they are sent or delivered.

6 Opening, Recording and Publications of Bids Received.

- Bids will be opened in public immediately after the bid closure date, or at such
- time as specified in the bid documents. If requested by any bidder present,
- names of the bidders, and if practical the total amount of each bid and of any alternative bids will be read out aloud.
- Bids received in time recorded and entered in a register which is open for public inspection.

7 Tax Clearance Certificate / SARS TCS Pin

- a. A valid original Tax Clearance Certificate must accompany the bid documents with a SARS TCS Pin for independent verification of Tax status as at Bid evaluation stage.
- b. Bids submission not supported by a valid original Tax Clearance Certificate and a SARS TCS Pin will be non-compliant.
- c. Consortia / joint ventures /sub-contractors are involved; each party must submit a separate valid original Tax Clearance Certificate and SARS TCS Pin.

8 Evaluation of Bids

10 Registration on Accredited Supplier Database

It is expected of all prospective service providers who are not yet registered on the Central Supplier Database to register online (<u>www.csd.gov.za</u>) and verify their company information at Garden Route District Municipality Database Department. The Garden Route District Municipality reserves the right not to award proposals to prospective suppliers who are not registered on the CSD (Central Supplier Database).

12 Stamp and Other Duties

The successful bidder will be liable for all duties and costs on legal documents resulting in the establishment of a contract and for the surety and retentions.

13 Language of Contract

The contract documents will be compiled in English and the English versions of all referred documents will be taken as applicable.

14 Procurement Policy

Bids will be awarded in accordance with the Preferential Procurement Policy of Garden Route District Municipality, pertaining to the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act, No 5 of 2000.

15 Expenses Incurred in Preparation of Bid

The Garden Route District Municipality shall not be liable for any expenses incurred in the preparation and submission of the bid.

16 Wrong Information Furnished

Where a contract has been awarded on the strength of the information furnished by the bidder which, after the conclusion of the relevant agreement, is proved to have been incorrect, the Garden Route District Municipality may, in addition to any other legal remedy it may have, recover from the contractor all costs, losses or damages incurred or sustained by the Municipality as a result of the award of the contract.

17 Validity Period

Bids shall remain valid for 120 days after the bid closure date.

18 General and Special Conditions of Contract

The General Conditions of Contract as well as any Special Conditions of Contract that may form part of this set of bid documents will be applicable to this bid in addition to the conditions of bid.

19 Municipal Rates, Taxes and Charges

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TERMS OF REFERENCE

INTRODUCTION

The purpose of the tender is to appoint a Panel of Service Providers for the supply, delivery and off-loading of Earthmoving Wear parts for a period of three years.

2. DEFINITION

Grader blades and/or supplementary wear parts for machinery.

3. DEMARCATION

To be supplied, delivered and off-loaded at the designated area in the Stores Divisions of Road Depots in

- George (Mission Road),
- Oudtshoorn (Voortrekker Road)
- Riversdale (Vermaaklikheid Road)

4. PRICE

- 4.1 Price must be fixed per year over a period of three years inclusive of VAT, supply, delivery, off-loading and handling costs.
- 4.2 <u>Price schedule</u>: Please note that you may only use the prescribed price schedule as provided in this tender document. No separate price schedules, lists or alternatives will be accepted.

6. UNITS

Only units/measurements as contained in the specifications (price schedule) must be tendered for. No alternatives will be accepted.

7. DELIVERY PERIOD

Maximum 10 working days after order has been issued and submitted.

8. MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

All Grader blades, cutting edges and ground engaging tools:

- Must be through-hardened medium carbon steel and must have a <u>minimum</u> of 43 Rockwell C hardness (HRC) or 400 Brinell hardness (BH) measured in the centre of the cross-section area of the blade. Should any other scale for hardness be used, Council must be supplied with the accredited comparison table to determine the equivalent hardness.
- > A certificate of hardness must be supplied by the manufacturer/supplier with blades on delivery.
- > All products must be 100% Local Content.

9. GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

- The holes of the blade must be punched and countersunk to accept plow bolts and nuts as per machine specifications and should be spaced accordingly.
- > All products must have a breakage guarantee.
- > All grader blades, cutting edges and ground engaging tools must be painted.
