PROPOSED MOSSEL BAY CREMATORIUM DEVELOPMENT

Notice is hereby given of a Public Participation Process in terms of the National Environmental Management Act (NEMA) and National Environmental Management Air Quality Act (NEMAQA).

An application for **Full Scoping & Impact Assessment** for a new Crematorium on Erf 50 in MossDustria Industrial Park (Mossel Bay) has been submitted to the Department of Environment Affairs & Development Planning (DEADP) and **Air Quality Emission License** (AEL) to be submitted to Garden Route District Municipality (GRDM).

Property: Erf 50, zoned Industrial Zone II in MossDustria Industrial Park, Mossel Bay.

Exemptions: No exemptions applied for.

Proposal: An existing brick, steel and corrugated iron building that is already on the property (Erf 50) will be modified to accommodate a crematorium where human and animal (pets) remains can be cremated. The facility will house three (3) cremators (new 14m stack to service all 3 ovens) and have an office and internal off-loading area. The crematorium will operate maximum 24hr/day, with two (2) operational cremators. An average of 32 cremations could be exercised per day i.e. 16 per cremator. The third cremator is a backup unit only for maintenance of the 2 primary cremators. Vehicles will offload human/animal remains through a dedicated entrance inside the building.

<u>Listed activities:</u> NEMA - **Listing 2**, **Activity 6** (activities for which an Air Emission License may be required). NEMAQA – **Category 8.2** (Crematoria and Veterinary waste incineration: Cremation of human, companion animals (pets) and veterinary waste).
