Programme and Entry Requirements

This is a three months unit standard-based skills programmme that requires 30% classroom (theory) and 70% workplace(practical) learning. Minimum entry requirements is:

• NQF Level 2 Qualifications with communication as a preference.

Scope of Work and Duties

- Conduct Security Patrol in area of responsibility
- Apply legal aspects in the area of responsibility
- Use of Security Equipment
- Handle complaints and problems
- Perform handover and take over responsibilities
- Give evidence in court
- Perform basic firefighting
- Carry out basic first aid treatment in a workplace
- Explain the requirements for becoming a security service provider

Stipends will be paid at R 2500-00 a month for three months by the Training Provider. Stipends must be used for meals and travel costs as no food or refreshments will be available during training. Programme also does not include uniforms, PPE or any equipment, but only learning materials.
