Programme and Entry Requirements

This is a three year occupationally based apprenticeship programme that includes a significant amount work-based learning in real working environment. Minimum entry requirements:

- NQF Level 1 with Mathematics and Science, with preference given to those applicants that have a National Senior Certificate with Mathematics and Science. Applicants that do not have Mathematics or Science or have Mathematical Literacy should not apply.

Scope of Work and Duties

- Plan and prepare the work site, equipment, tools, consumables and materials for electrical activities and operations.
- Install, wire and connect electrical equipment and control systems.
- Test and inspect electrical equipment, control systems and installations.
- Commission control systems and installations.
- Maintain and repair electrical equipment, control systems and installations.

Stipends will be paid over the three year period and stipends must be used for meals and travel costs as no food or refreshments will be available during training.

The current GRSM / EPWP application forms are available at the Garden Route District Municipality (GRDM) and satellite offices within the district during normal office hours (Monday – Thursday 07:30 – 16:30; Friday 07:30 – 13:30).
