## 1. Definitions

1. The following terms shall be interpreted as indicated:
1.1 "Closing time" means the date and hour specified in the bidding documents for the receipt of bids.
1.2 "Contract" means the written agreement entered into between the purchaser and the provider, as recorded in the contract form signed by the parties, including all attachments and appendices thereto and all documents incorporated by reference therein.
1.3 "Contract price" means the price payable to the provider under the contract for the full and proper performance of his contractual obligations.
1.4 "Corrupt practice" means the offering, giving, receiving, or soliciting of anything of value to influence the action of a public official in the procurement process or in contract execution.
1.5 "Countervailing duties" are imposed in cases where an enterprise abroad is subsidized by its government and encouraged to market its products internationally.
1.6 "Country of origin" means the place where the goods were mined, grown or produced or from which the services are supplied.
