

STANDARDS FOR ACCOMMODATION ESTABLISHMENTS



HEALTH CERTIFICATE

- The premises must operate under a valid Health Certificate issued by the Garden Route District Municipality (GRDM).
- A Health Certificate is issued by an Environmental Health Practitioner (EHP) once the premises complies with the Norms and Standards for Accommodation Establishments.
- The Health Certificate must be renewed annually, or when there is a change in ownership, renovations or additions are made to the premises, or when the business relocates to a new site.



CERTIFICATE OF ACCEPTABILITY (COA)

- Apply for a Certificate of Acceptability (CoA) at the Garden Route District Municipality (GRDM).
- All facilities involved in the handling, preparation, storage, or serving of food must comply with the relevant regulations issued under the Foodstuffs, Cosmetics and Disinfectants Act, 1972 (Act 54 of 1972), as amended.



SMOKING REGULATIONS

- The premises must comply with the Regulations Relating to Smoking in Public Places and Certain Outdoor Public Places (R264 of 30 March 2012), issued under the Tobacco Products Control Act, 1993 (Act 83 of 1993), as amended.



WATER QUALITY

- Drinking water on the premises must comply with the South African National Standard (SANS 241), which sets the minimum requirements for water to be considered safe for human consumption.
